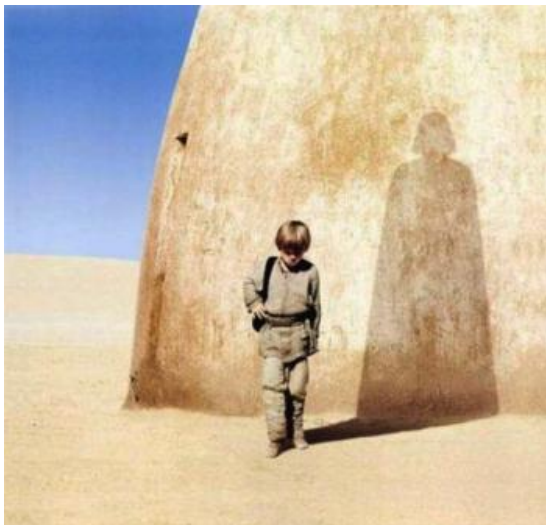

### Foreshadowing

- Foreshadowing occurs when future events in a story are suggested by the author before they actually happened.
- For example, in "Rikki-tikki-tavi":
  - "He'll do no such thing," said the father. "Teddy's safer with that little beast than if he had a bloodhound to watch him. If a snake came into the nursery now--"
  - The statement by the father foreshadows the conflict with Nag and Nagaina that occurs later in the story
