- 4. Given a rhetorical passage, identify the argument and the emotional appeals used. Is it an effective piece?
- 5. Given a passage from *The Raven*, identify 3 poetic elements. Define those poetic terms and explain how they are used in the passage.
- 6. Write a descriptive paragraph that includes 3 of the following: imagery, metaphor, simile, personification, or alliteration.
- Know the elements of an epic. Explain why *The Odyssey* meets the criteria for being an epic.

- Explain how *Romeo and Juliet* meet the criteria for being a tragedy. DOUBLE POINTS. See
 12.1.1 Include: hamartia, catharsis, and tragic hero. Explain how R & J meet those criteria.
