1. Write a short biography of someone you know. What should go in a biography? How should it be written?
2. What is the difference between fictional and nonfictional writing? Be able to explain the difference with specific examples from stories you've read in this semester.
3. Given a topic by me, write a short persuasive speech or opinion editorial. Take a stand! Stay current. Provide solutions. Use examples. Address the opposition.
4. Given a rhetorical passage, identify the argument and the emotional appeals used. Is it an effective piece?
5. Given a passage from *The Raven*, identify 3 poetic elements. Define those poetic terms and explain how they are used in the passage.
6. Write a descriptive paragraph that includes 3 of the following: imagery, metaphor, simile, personification, or alliteration.
7. Know the elements of an epic. Explain why *The Odyssey* meets the criteria for being an epic. **DOUBLE POINTS. See 11.1.1 Write down the traits then explain how The Odyssey meets them. All of 11.1.1 will do this.**
8. Write a problem-solution paragraph
9. Explain how *Romeo and Juliet* meet the criteria for being a tragedy. **DOUBLE POINTS. See 12.1.1 Include: hamartia, catharsis, and tragic hero. Explain how R & J meet those criteria.**
10. Given 5 sentences, fix the misplaced modifiers.
